A project that was 10 years in the making is finally coming to fruition for LSO's music director and concertmaster.

Edward Polochick and Anton Miller will present a recital of violin and piano music on Sunday, November 15, at 4 p.m. at the Sheldon Museum of Art. The program will include works by Beethoven, Debussy, Kreisler, and others.

"We are so excited to finally make this dream a reality," Miller said. "It is music that is close to our hearts and we believe will be shared with the hearts of our audience.

"The best part of playing this program together is that we will be able to showcase Ed's prodigious talent and musicianship along with the special musical connection he and I have with each other," Miller said.

Following the recital, Ed and Anton will be available for questions and conversation during a cocktails and hors d'oeuvres reception. The galleries in the museum will be open before and after the recital for no additional charge.

Tickets are \$50 each for LSO subscribers and \$60 each for non-subscribers. Subscribers must order their tickets over the phone to receive the discount.
